### 1. Leadership

The Student Union Leadership Award recognizes a student leader who has been integral to enhancing the UFV community. Whether through collaborative programming, academic support, international integration, or a multitude of other avenues, the recipient will have made a meaningful contribution to the UFV community. Leaders are not only those called 'President' or 'Manager;' leadership is shown through action, not by title, and those actions are what this award recognizes.

Note: Leadership roles may be paid or unpaid, however paid leadership contributions will be considered only if the position is restricted to current students (work study, RAs, etc.)

#### Criteria

- Currently registered UFV student in good academic standing (minimum GPA 2.0)
- Evidence of leadership throughout the 2016-2017 academic year
- Demonstrated contribution to UFV students and/or the UFV community
- Passion for leading positive change within UFV
- Statement up to 500 words explaining how the nominee meets the criteria and is deserving of this award

### 2. Volunteer

The Student Union Volunteer Award recognizes an exemplary student volunteer within the UFV student community. Volunteers are the backbone of all student effort on campus, and the dedication exhibited by some of these volunteers is extraordinary. The recipient may be running tours at New Student Orientation, or quietly working before an event decorating the venue. Regardless of their duties, the recipient will have shown their utmost commitment to the task, going above and beyond what was asked.

#### Criteria

- Currently registered UFV student in good academic standing (minimum GPA 2.0)
- Evidence of volunteerism throughout the 2016-2017 academic year

- Commitment to chosen volunteer activities, as shown through reliability, long-term involvement, or other traits
- Statement up to 500 word explaining how the nominee meets the criteria and is deserving of this award

### **3. Club or Association**

The Student Union Club or Association Award honours a student group that has fulfilled their mandate and improved the experience at UFV for members and/or the broader campus community. Student groups manage a diverse array of events, programming, support, and volunteerism in all aspects of the student community. The recipient will have built community at UFV, and provided opportunities for students to further their interests and to support fellow students or others within the mandate of the group.

#### **Criteria**

- Currently registered SUS club or organization
- Actively programming activities through the year related to the group's mandate
- Providing opportunities for current and new members to contribute to the group
- Statement up to 500 word explaining how the nominee meets the criteria and is deserving of this award

### **4. Student Supporting Indigenous Reconciliation**

The Student Supporting Indigenous Reconciliation Award recognizes a student leader who is committed to the ongoing work of implementing recommendations of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission to Indigenize the campus community (inside and/or outside the classroom). This work may seek to honour stories and histories of Indigenous people, recognize and respect Indigenous ways of knowing and being, or otherwise contribute to making our campus welcoming for Indigenous cultures, knowledge, and learners.

#### **Criteria**

- Currently registered UFV student in good academic standing (minimum GPA 2.0)
- Demonstrated contribution to truth and reconciliation efforts at UFV during the 2016-2017 academic year
- Statement up to 500 word explaining how the nominee meets the criteria and is deserving of this award
