### General Updates from the Vice President External

#### 1.1. Fraser Health

After communicating with Fraser Health UFV SUS has supplied the updated resources UFVSUS members have with their issued health and dental plans. This was a follow-up solution to a request of updated information to UFV students going to Fraser Health and some staff not knowing the services pre-existing for SUS students. The information shared with Fraser Health was information that is in extensive detail with direction to the options insured students and not insured students have with an extensive list of resources that our students have available to them for both scenarios of coverage and non-coverage.

#### 1.2. Introduction with Alumni

A meeting was set up for all the SUS Executives and SUS Executive Director to meet with the Alumni Board for introductions. Serving as a function for a personal connection when working with Alumni resources in the future and improves the future of our relationship with a direct connection between the boards.
