

When I am not out advocating on student issues, I love playing sports, hanging out with friends, and giving back to the community in whatever way I can.




Why am I running for




What are my goals?

My goals as President include:


- Re-establish the UFVSUS inter-campus shuttle so that students will have an efficient and cost-effective way to get between campuses.




- Establish more opportunities to support students in getting jobs after graduation by working alongside the UFV Alumni Association.





- -Increase engagement and variety of events students want on campus.
